1. Meetings are held in the Southeast Community Facility either in the Alex Pitcher Community Room or Conference Room 5 1800 Oakdale Ave, S.F, CA 94124 or at Earl P. Mills Auditorium 100 Whitney Young Circle, S.F, CA 94124, or an alternative, accessible location in the Bayview Hunters Point community in San Francisco. The meeting rooms are wheelchair accessible and have accessible seating for persons with disabilities and those using wheelchairs.
2. The closest accessible BART station is 24<sup>th</sup> and Mission to both the Southeast Community Facility and the Earl P. Mills Auditorium. Accessible Muni lines serving the Southeast Community Facility include #23 Monterey, 324 Divisadero, #44 O'Shaughnessy, and #54 Felton buses, and the T Third Street LRT; lines serving the Earl P. Mills Auditorium include #44 O'Shaughnessy, and #54 Felton buses. Further information can be obtained by calling 415-923-6142.
3. There is accessible parking on the street at the Southeast Community Facility. Public parking is not available in the Community Facility parking lot; please do not park in this lot. There is accessible parking in the parking lot at the Earl P. Mills Auditorium, and on nearby streets.
4. The following services are available by calling 415-647-6857 at least 72 hours prior to the meeting: American Sign Language interpreters, use of a reader during a meeting, or a sound enhancement system. Following a meeting, minutes can be made available upon request by tape or alternative formats.
